A. Completion rates for all individuals who participated and are due to complete the training program within the 12 month period in which data is available.	60%
B. Percentage of all individuals who participated in the training program (whether they completed or not) who obtained unsubsidized employment.	60%
C. Average wage at placement of all individuals who participated in the training program (whether they completed or not).	120% of federal minimum wage
D. Maximum percentage of individuals enrolled who are WIA-Funded Participants.	Maximum 75%

G. Average wages after 6 months of employment from the first date of employment for those WIA participants who completed the program.	120% of federal minimum wage
H. Rates of licensure or certification, attainment of academic degrees or equivalents, or attainment of other measures of skills for WIA participants who graduated from the training program.	60%
